

Introduction

Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales (ICAEW) scheme of Pathways to Membership allows fully qualified members (minimum five years of full membership) from certain professional bodies – listed below to apply for ICAEW membership based on their experience. Eligible applicants complete Examination of Experience questions that assess their achievements, experience, professional approach, skills and expertise.

After successful passing Examination of Experience, applicant will be invited to apply for membership through payment of membership & admission fees and after receiving of invitation to membership from ICAEW, applicant become member straight away and can use ACA designation. Overall process from submission of Examination of Experience document and availing ICAEW Membership takes approximately four months.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants can apply for ICAEW membership through Pathways if they meet the full eligibility criteria as mentioned below.

1) Applicant must be fully qualified current member holding full membership from one of the bodies listed below;

- The Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) – UK
- The Chartered Institute of Public Finance and Accountancy (CIPFA) – UK
- The Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan (ICAP) – Pakistan
- The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) – India
- The Institute of Chartered Accountants of Bangladesh (ICAB) – Bangladesh
- The Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka (CA Sri Lanka) – Sri Lanka
- The Institute of Chartered Accountants of Nepal (ICAN – Nepal) – Nepal
- The Chinese Institute of Certified Public Accountants (CICPA) – China
- The Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants (HKICPA) – Hong Kong
- The Institute of Chartered Accountants (Ghana) (ICAG) – Ghana
- The Institute of Chartered Accountants of Nigeria (ICAN – Nigeria) – Nigeria
- The Institute of Certified Public Accountants of Kenya (ICPAK) – Kenya
- The Institute of Certified Public Accountants of Greece (SOEL) – Greece

2) Applicant must have at least five years of full membership of any professional body mentioned above;

3) Applicant must have gained membership of that professional body through the normal education and training route

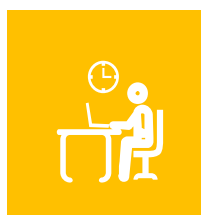
4) As a fully qualified current member, applicant is compliant with the continuing professional development (CPD) requirements of the professional body.

5) Applicant is a member in good standing with a good disciplinary record and no outstanding complaints against applicant

6) Applicant application is supported by an eligible sponsor. This must be an individual who holds current membership of a professional body that is a full IFAC member body and who knows you, and who is in good standing, is compliant with the CPD requirements of that body and who has a good disciplinary record with no complaints outstanding against them.

Procedure for obtaining ICAEW Membership

Examination of Experience consists of a series of questions, which applicant complete in his/her own time, and submit in the required template format by the specified submission deadline. The questions generally assess following aspects;

- Ethical awareness and professional judgement;
- Planning and analytical skills;
- Quality of thought;
- Past experience and achievement; and
- Awareness of current and technical issues.

All eligible applicants are entitled to a maximum of up to four attempts to pass the Examination of Experience.



Price and Dates

Registration Fee of ICAEW:

Free – Only eligible candidates who intend to submit an application at some point in the near future should register as a candidate.

Examination of Experience fee of ICAEW:

£300 per attempt (non-refundable) – This is an exam admission fee and is payable with each Pathways exam submission you make.
